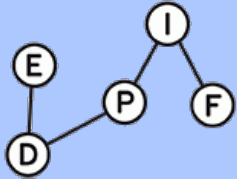
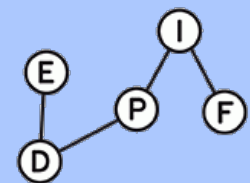


ED Physique en Ile de France (EDPIF)

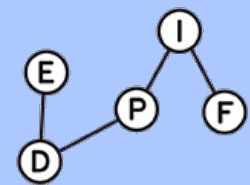

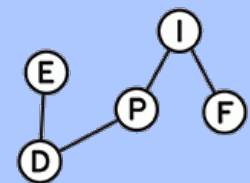

Support for doctoral students

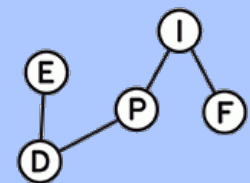
- **Registration meeting** with the deputy director of the establishment.
- **Doctoral guide.**
- **Mandatory appointment** at the end of the 1st year.
- **Monitoring committee: « Parrain » + scientific tutor.**
- **Specific monitoring committee.** (if conflict or difficulties)
- **Validation of the defense jury**

- **Additional training.** (90 hours min in three categories: scientific, open and transversal).
- **Animation. Three mandatory meetings:** Welcome Day, Scientific Day, career pursuit workshop



Supervision of PhD students

- The doctoral student must be funded until the defense.
- Different sources of financial PhD work:
ANR, ERC, CIFRE, LABEX, IDEX, Fondations, ED competition....
- Supervision limited to 3 doctoral/HDR students, taking into account co-supervision
- Duration of theses 38 months on average.

Competition jury (interview at the beginning of June)

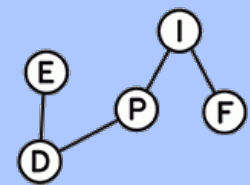
- 1 competition committee (board of directors +4members=8 members)
- 1 selection jury (competition committee + 12 members= 20 membres en 4 sous-jurys)

En 2024: 189 applications on subjects submitted on the ED website.

113 preselected by the office (of which 24 resigned before audition) 89 auditioned.

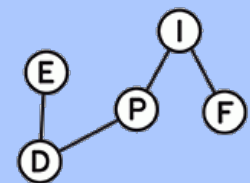

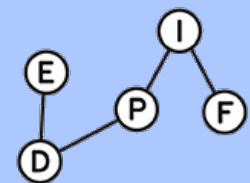
ED competition

- The competition procedure is conducted in three successive phases:
- 1) Approval by the Board of the ED of proposed thesis topics posted on the [ADUM website](#);
- 2) Submission of applications to [ADUM website](#);
- Ranking of candidates by a [the competition and selection juries](#) chosen to represent all the themes of the ED. This ranking is then approved by the Council of the ED.



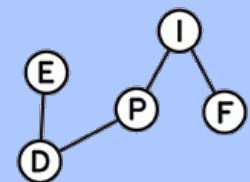
Calendar ED competition

- **Starting on the end of January 2025:** Submission of thesis proposals on page ADUM Proposal are approved continuously by the Board of the ED.
- **February 2025:** Opening of the submission of applications on ADUM for the 2025 recruitment campaign. Submission is possible only for thesis proposals previously approved by the Board of the ED.
- **Friday, April 11th 2025 at 13:00:** Deadline for submission of thesis proposal taking part to competition.
- **Friday, April 18th 2025 at Midnight:** Deadline for submission of applications for the competition.



Calendar ED competition

- **Tuesday, April 22nd 2025 at Midnight** : Deadline for submission of candidates' academic records.
- **Friday, May 16th 2025 at 13:00**: Publication of the list of competition candidates selected for an interview
- From **Tuesday 03 to Thursday, June 05 2025**: Interviews and ranking of candidates.
- **Wednesday, June 11th 2025 at 13:00**: Publication of the competition results.
