



Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions **Doctoral Networks**

Supporting excellence in doctoral training across Europe and beyond



Objective:

To implement structured doctoral training programs through international, intersectoral, and interdisciplinary partnerships, aiming to train highly skilled doctoral candidates equipped for academic and non-academic careers.



Three Implementation Modes:

- Standard Doctoral Networks (DN): Focused on academic excellence and transferable skills.
- Industrial Doctorates (DN-ID): Joint supervision between academia and industry; at least 50% of time spent in the non-academic sector.
- Joint Doctorates (DN-JD): Leading to joint or multiple degrees; integrated cooperation and supervision.



Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral Fellowships



To empower postdoctoral researchers with advanced training, international mobility, interdisciplinary skills, and career development



Two Fellowship Types

- European PF: 12–24 months in an EU Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country; open to any nationality
- Global PF: 24–36 months (12–24 months outside Europe + mandatory 12-month return phase); for EU nationals or long-term residents

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Staff Exchanges



Promote short-term international, intersectoral, and interdisciplinary exchanges of research & innovation staff to foster knowledge transfer, strengthen collaboration, and build capacity across sectors and countries



Who Can Apply:

- Consortia of ≥3 organizations from 3 different countries, including at least 2 from EU/Associated Countries
- All sectors (academic, non-academic), mobility across sectors encouraged; samesector exchanges capped at ⅓ of project
- Eligible staff: researchers (PhD to senior), technical, administrative, and managerial staff engaged in R&I (employed ≥1 month prior)



Co-fund excellence in doctoral & postdoctoral training through regional, national, or international programmes, promoting MSCA best practices and high-quality working conditions



★ Two Programme Types

Doctoral Programmes – structured PhD training leading to a doctoral degree.

Postdoctoral Programmes – advanced fellowships for postdoctoral researchers

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions MSCA & Citizens



Bring research and researchers closer to the general public— especially families, pupils, and students—through engaging activities such as the European Researchers' Night and Researchers at Schools



Key Actions

- European Researchers' Night: Annual event on the last Friday in September (up to 2 days), featuring exhibitions, hands-on experiments, science shows, games, debates, and quizzes
- Researchers at Schools: Year-round initiative where researchers visit primary/secondary schools to discuss societal challenges like climate change, health, and sustainable development

Increase Europe's attractiveness as a research destination by offering stable, long-term career prospects and top-tier working conditions, aiming to turn brain drain into brain gain



Representation Representation of the second secon

- Applicants: A single legal entity in EU Member State or Horizon Europe **Associated Country (can include partners).**
- Researchers: Recruits must hold a doctorate and comply with MSCA mobility rules (≤12 months in country within 36 months prior). Should not be already permanently employed by the host

Deadline: 03 December 2025



Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions MSCA4Ukraine

Background & Purpose



- Launched under MSCA to support researchers displaced by Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine.
- Builds on the initial MSCA4Ukraine scheme (since 2022) that provided safe research environments for Ukrainian scholars



Target Audience

- Doctoral & postdoctoral researchers displaced from Ukraine.
- Open to any field; hosted by academia, industry, research centres, or public institutions in the EU and associated countries


