IHEPCCC Mission Statement

Missions

IHEPCCC primary mission is to act as a forum between the main persons in charge of HEP computing, by gathering and distributing information about all relevant issues in HEP computing, and especially those with a global nature. Typical examples are information exchanges about new technology trends, computing centers strategic policies, security issues, recommendation of standard practices, presentation of R&D results, comparison of various equipments performances.

The other missions include:

- Issuing statements and recommendations concerning computing in the HEP community.

- Serving as an interface to other scientific domains on matters of computing.

- Working in close connection with the ICFA SCIC, the physics regional organizations, and the HICB coordinating the grid projects in HEP.

Activities I

- VO (completed)
 - ◆ Visitor networks (printing)
 - ◆ Grid VO (national, experiment)
 - ◆ *IHEPCCC should continue to encourage the Labs to support the visitor infrastructure*
- Training
 - ◆ General training (schools, C++ courses)
 - ◆ Experiment software
 - ◆ *IHEPCCC should recommend that Labs and Expts should support such courses and provide online information (eg Kunst C++ lectures)*

Activities II

- Common HEP Software
 - ◆ Application SW (Geant4, Root, ...)
 - ◆ Technical SW (SL, dCache/CASTOR, ...)
 - ◆ Grid middleware
 - ◆ *IHEPCCC needs to discuss this topic*
- Software licensing
 - ◆ A number of commercial products are licensed to Labs and/or experiments (eg. ORACLE, Objectivity,)
 - ◆ Previous meeting discussed Mathematica or Matlab.
 - ◆ *IHEPCCC should make a list of what is being used*

Activities III

- Teleconferencing and video conferencing
 - ◆ Most robust is telephone plus web
 - user cost is dropping with VOIP (UVictoria spends \$600 CDN/month)
 - Commercial conference infrastructure is still expensive
 - Mixture of commercial and home-grown solutions
 - Not always convenient during non-working hours
 - ◆ VRVS (video solutions)
 - OK but not a robust solution (IHEPCCC uses the phone!)
 - Difficult to use VC facilities for non-working hours
 - ◆ *IHEPCCC could gather information on existing teleconference systems*

Activities IV

- Report to ICFA
 - ◆ IHEPCCC reports to ICFA (twice per year)
 - ◆ Should we provide a written report like the SCIC?
- Other suggestions?

Technical groups

- HEPix
 - ◆ Request review talk from HEPix after Rome meeting (April 2006)
- Network
 - ◆ Ask for report from SCIC at next meeting
- Grid
 - ◆ HICB was organized to foster collaboration between the various grid activities (see next slide)
 - ◆ There is collaboration between the major Grid HEP projects.
 - Smaller HEP grid projects?
 - ◆ *What should IHEPCCC do in this area?*

- *Representatives of the management of GriPhyN, EDG, PPDG, CrossGrid, GridPP, French Grid, NL Grid, Japanese Data Grids...*
- *Now adding DataTag, iVDGL and LHC Computing Grid Project. Other projects as they startup.*
- *Representatives of computing and software project management of HENP Experiments participate as available.*
- *Board represents managements of other projects; does not manage the projects itself!*
- *Meets 3 times a year in proximity to GGF meetings.*
- *Chair is Larry Price from Argonne.*
