- (covid note) Health is a priority:

 - Current rules in France for covid positive cases:
 - for vaccinated people and/or under 12 years old: isolation of 7 days, you could go out after 5 days in case of a second negative test and no symptoms for 48h
 - for non-vaccinated people over 12 years old: isolation of 10 days, you could go out after 7 days in case of a second negative test and no symptoms for 48h
