

RGPD information notice

Participation in events, organisation of conferences

The information collected about you will be processed by the administration of DIM QuantIP (CNRS LPL UMR7538), 99 av. Jean-Baptiste Clément, 93430 Villetaneuse.

The CNRS Data Protection Officer can be contacted for any information on the processing – dpd.demandes@cnrs.fr.

Personal data are collected and processed for the organisation of the conferences/events. The legal basis for the processing is the legitimate interest pursued by the controller (cf. Article 6.1.f of the European Data Protection Regulation).

According to their respective needs, the event organisers are recipients of the data.

No data will be transferred outside the European Union.

Your personal data will be kept for a period of 2 months after the end of the conference.

In compliance with the applicable legal and regulatory provisions, in particular Law No. 78-17 of 6 January amended relating to data processing, files and freedoms and European Regulation No. 2016/679/EU of 27 April 2016 (applicable since 25 May 2018), you have the following rights:

- Exercise your right of access, to know the personal data concerning you.
- Request the updating of your data, if it is inaccurate.
- Request portability (to communicate your data to the person of your choice) or erasure of your data.
- Request the deletion of your account.
- Request the limitation of the processing of your data.
- Oppose, for legitimate reasons, the processing of your data.
- Withdraw your consent to the processing of your data.
